**DELEGATION OF COMPTROLLER'S POWERS TO COMPOUND
OFFENCE**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 155(3) of the Customs Act 1986, the Minister has delegated all the powers of the Comptroller under the provisions of section 155—

- (a) to the Deputy Comptroller of Customs & Excise;
- (b) to each Principal Collector of Customs:

Provided that any sum ordered by them to be paid shall not exceed three times the value of the goods involved or \$1,000 whichever is the less;

- (c) to each Senior Collector of Customs:

Provided that any sum ordered by them to be paid shall not exceed three times the value of the goods involved or \$500 whichever is the less; and

- (d) to each Collector of Customs:

Provided that any sum ordered by them to be paid shall not exceed three times the value of the goods involved or \$100 whichever is the less.
