CUSTOMS ACT 1986

Customs (Prohibited Imports and Exports) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2019

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 64 of the Customs Act 1986, I hereby make these Regulations—

Short title and commencement

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Prohibited Imports and Exports) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2019.

(2) These Regulations are deemed to have come into force on 8 June 2019.

Schedule 3 amended

2. The Customs (Prohibited Imports and Exports) Regulations 1986 is amended in Schedule 3 by—

- (a) in the preamble, deleting “paragraph 5” and substituting “paragraphs 5 and 6”;
- (b) after paragraph 5, inserting the following new paragraph—

“A used or reconditioned vehicle loaded for shipment to Fiji or paid for on or before 7 June 2019 may still be imported provided that the importer proves to the Comptroller that the used or reconditioned vehicle was loaded for shipment to Fiji or was paid for on or before 7 June 2019.”; and
- (c) in paragraph 6—
 - (i) after “A new vehicle” inserting “loaded for shipment to Fiji or”;
 - (ii) after “that the new vehicle” inserting “was loaded for shipment to Fiji or”; and
 - (iii) after “7 June 2019.” inserting “A new vehicle pre-ordered on or before 7 June 2019 may also be imported provided that the importer proves to the Comptroller that the new vehicle was pre-ordered on or before 7 June 2019 and the shipment of such pre-ordered new vehicle arrives in Fiji on or before 31 December 2019.”.
