

### Importation of Personal Effects

Provisions of concession code 219; under part three of Customs Tariff

Condition for Allowance	
1	Applicable to bona-fide passenger finally disembarking in Fiji
2	Personal effects including professional instruments, apparatus and implements
Allowance Details	
1	Goods are owned by passenger at the time of his arrival in Fiji and are for his personal use: and
2	Goods are not intended for gifts or for sale or exchange : and
3	Good are used prior to importation: and
4	Not imported into Fiji more than 12 months after the date of disembarkation of the passenger: and
5	Goods are of a kind and of a quantity which FRCS Officer is satisfied that a passenger may reasonably carry in his or her baggage

### Importation of Household Goods

Provisions of concession code 220; under part three of Customs Tariff

Condition for Allowance	
1	Applicable to persons namely <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Any person taking initial resident in Fiji or</li> <li>b. Any person on work permit for one year or more issued by Department of Immigration of Fiji</li> <li>c. Any returning resident of Fiji</li> </ul>
2	Applicable to new and used household effects.
Allowance Details	
1	Goods are owned by passenger at the time of his arrival in Fiji and are for his personal use: and
2	Goods are not intended for gifts or for sale or exchange : and
3	Not imported into Fiji more than 12 months after the date of disembarkation of the passenger: and
4	Goods are of a kind and of a quantity which FRCS Officer is satisfied that a passenger may reasonably be expected to keep in his or her household
Condition of Vehicle Importation	
1	Only one used motor vehicle per family is allowed
2	The person should prove to FRCS that he or she is returning to Fiji permanently : and
3	The person should have a valid visa: and
4	The vehicle must be owned and a period of 12 months or more such as registration papers, sales / purchase invoice required) and
5	The vehicle must be of arrival of the person in Fiji: and
6	The vehicle should be less than 5 years from the year of manufacture for petrol/ diesel and for LPG, CNG, Solar and EURO 4 compliant
7	That the concession be subject to such other conditions as Comptroller may impose : and
8	That the disposal or use of goods for purpose other than that for which concession is granted be subject to the conditions laid down in Section 17 of the Customs Tariff

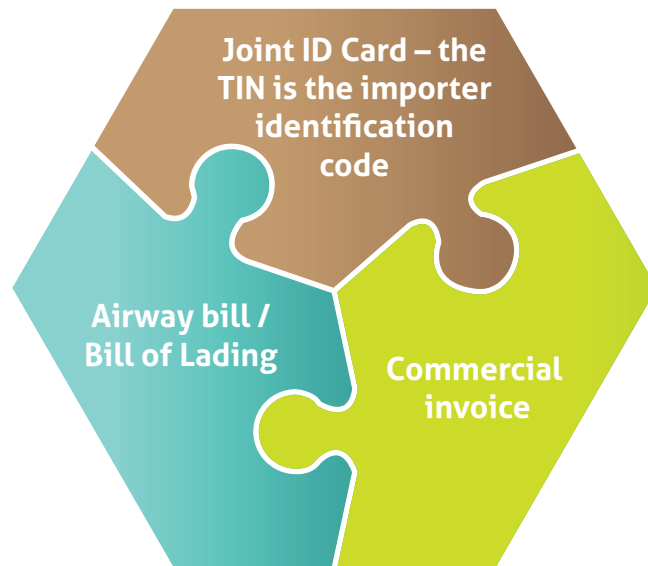

# Requirements for import

The following documents are to be presented by an importer whilst wanting to clear any imported goods:



## Personal clearance

The clearance of personal goods that are valued at less than FJD\$1000 and arrive through Parcel Post or Air freight or Sea freight are cleared on BA4 model of declaration, which will be registered and assessed by FRCS Officer. In the instance if the value of the good is more than FJD \$1000.00 then it is advisable that the importer engage a License Customs Agent for formal clearance

## Commercial clearance

Customers are required to engage licensed Customs agent to clear their commercial goods from FRCS. The goods should be cleared formally on Customs Entry by licensed Customs agent.

However, clearance of commercial samples that are valued less than FJD\$500.00 and other goods whose value is less than \$100.00 and arrive through Parcel Post or Air freight are cleared on BA4 model of declaration, which will be registered and assessed by FRCS Officer.

# Requirements for export

The following documents together with the goods are to be presented by an exporter whilst wanting to export any good:

- Joint ID Card – the TIN is the importer identification code
- Commercial invoice

It is advisable that the exporter engage a Licensed Customs Agent for the following exports:

- Commercial goods with value more than FJD\$100.00
- Temporary export for repair and return
- Export under drawback
- Re exported goods
- Personal export with value more than FJD \$1,000.00

If the goods are personal export, then the Customs officer would facilitate export on the Bill of Lading or Airway Bill provided the value of the export is less than FJD \$1,000.00.

It is very important to note that when importing or exporting goods individuals are to ensure that the product they import or export is not prohibited. Whilst there are certain goods subject to restrictions that require import or export license.

# Imports & Personal Allowance

## Goods Imported by Air freight or Parcel Post by individual

Provisions of concession code 212; under part three of Customs Tariff

	Condition
1	All goods except for liquor or tobacco, that the value of such goods does not exceed FJD \$400.00 and
2	Goods are for use of the addressee or the importer and
3	Goods are not for sale or to be commercially used
4	That the FRCS officer may at his or her discretion determine that more than one parcel consigned to the same or several consignees, may be treated as a single parcel and in such cases duty shall be assessed accordingly

## Passenger Allowance

Provisions of concession code 218; under part three of Customs Tariff

	Condition for Allowance
1	Applicable to bona-fide passenger finally disembarking in Fiji
2	Goods are not for sale
3	Goods are accompanied at the time of final disembarking by the passenger or
4	Goods are purchased immediately after final disembarkation into Fiji by the passenger
Allowance Details	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• cigarettes not exceeding 200 sticks or</li> <li>• cigars not exceeding 200 sticks or</li> <li>• tobacco not exceeding 200 g net weight or</li> <li>• any combination of the above goods provided the total net does not exceed 200 g and</li> <li>• spirituous liquor not exceeding 2.25 liters or</li> <li>• wine not exceeding 4.5 liters or</li> <li>• beer not exceeding 4.5 liters or</li> <li>• any combination of the above goods provided that the combination does not exceed the equivalent quantity and</li> <li>• other dutiable goods not exceeding F1,000.00 in value or F2,000.00 for holder of Gold Card</li> </ul>
