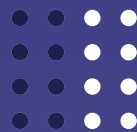

Tertiary Entry Level Paid Program (TELPP)

Purpose



The Fiji Revenue and Customs Service has embarked on the introduction of an early level recruitment program through the Tertiary Entry Level Paid Program (TELPP) which provides an early engagement point, aiming to attract, recruit and retain high quality tertiary students undertaking the Bachelor's Program or above and looking for paid work experience aligned to their current studies.

What you need to know about the program?



The entry level program goes a step further than conventional graduate programs where it is aimed at students who have only completed their first year of undergraduate studies, essentially leaving two years for most relevant undergraduate programs and one year for customs related undergraduate programs.

Candidate selection would be based on the GPA of the student and those successful would be rotated through several departments in their first year where the intention is to develop their knowledge across the various divisions and departments within FRCS. At the end of year 1, the candidate will undergo comprehensive training on basic

custom matters and assessed on the same. The candidate will move on to their key role in their second year should they be successful at the assessment phase.

Students under the program would earn a salary based on their hours of work with a minimum of 20 hours per week and up to a maximum of 30 hours for those enrolled full time but only undertaking one unit in a semester (final semester). Students who are not under scholarship would be entitled to reimbursement of remaining units based on their grades and assessments by Fiji Revenue and Customs Service. Students would be bonded for 12 months to 36 months depending on the level of investment made by the Service.

Programme Selection Criteria



The program will be piloted in the 2024 calendar year and the applications will open from October 2023.

- Applicable to Fijian Citizens who have 2 years left on their tertiary program (100% completion of 100 level units).
- Meets GPA requirements for the field of study.
- Successfully completes the recruitment processes which may include; aptitude tests and/or interviews.
